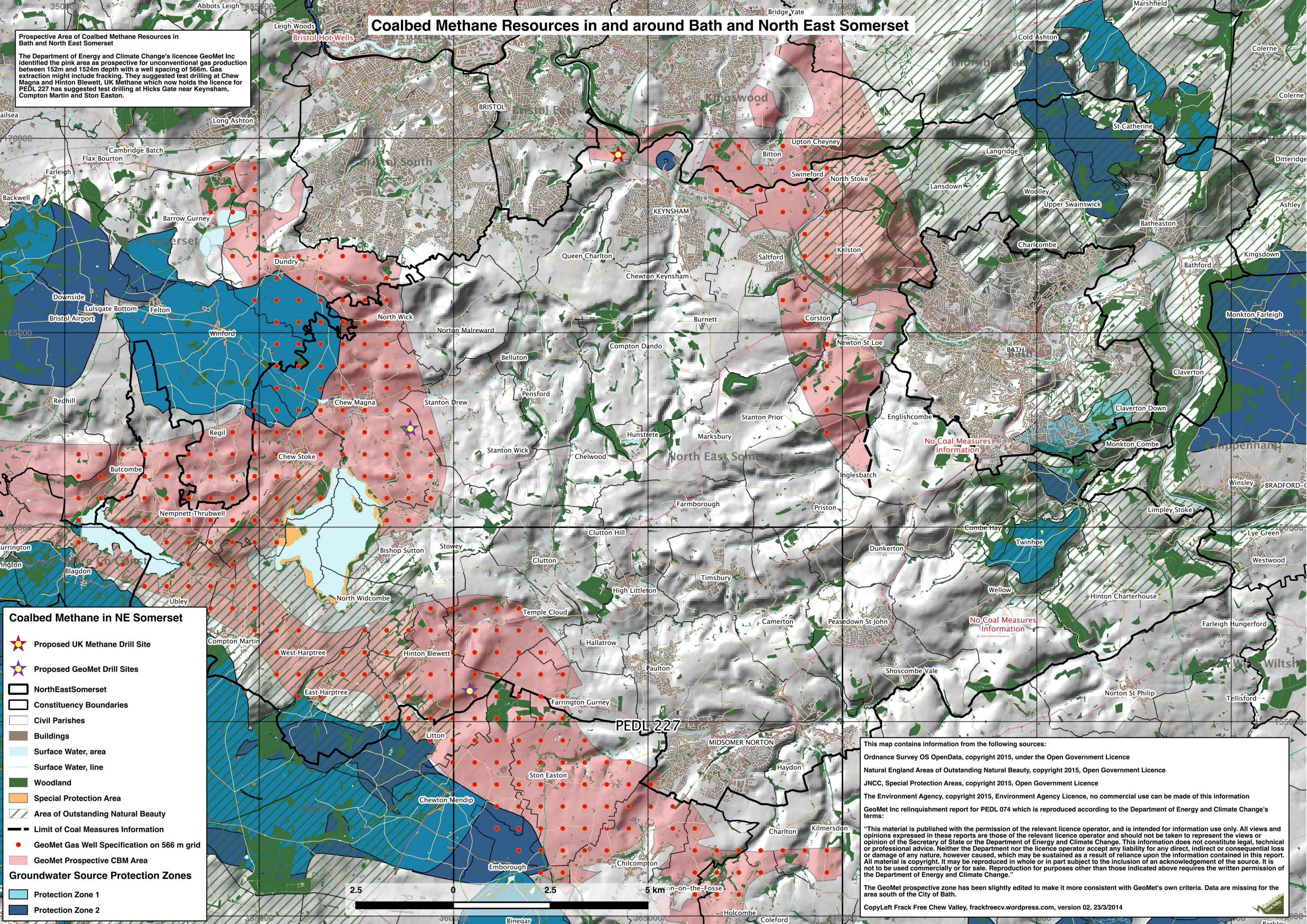


Coalbed Methane Resources in and around Bath and North East Somerset

Prospective Area of Coalbed Methane Resources in Bath and North East Somerset

The Department of Energy and Climate Change's licences GeoMet Inc identified the pink area as prospective for unconventional gas production between 152m and 1524m depth with a well spacing of 566m. Gas extraction might include fracking. They suggested test drilling at Chew Magna and Hinton Blewett, UK Methane which now holds the licence for PEDL 227 has suggested test drilling at Hicks Gate near Keynsham, Compton Martin and Ston Easton.
